



LOGLINE

Many years after dreaming of his own suicide, "Father" Lucius – an unusual priest – must confront himself with his past to help a mysterious young bride who wants to walk away from her wedding. But will the truth save her?



SYNOPSIS

Lucius is a 20-year old immigrated Frenchman living in Boston MA who wants to kill himself. One night, on his way home, ready to commit suicide, Lucius has a tragical encounter. This will then make him hallucinate of his deceased brother before becoming a spectator of his own funerals.

18 years later, Father Lucius Green is at his church when the bride of the day comes in to talk with him. After some time, Lucius figures out that there's a big wound in her. But when he finally gets her to talk, he understands who she really is. Lucius is suddenly brought back to the darkness of his past. Therefore, the two are going on a tale where Lucius is going to tell her the story when he dreamt of his own life after death. But when the bridesmaid enters the church to pick Anny up, Lucius has to decides whether he will tell the whole truth or not...

A deep reflection on suicide and the tragedies of life, and how to build yourself with it. Some might say that **TRUTHCE** was born out of craziness, and they might be right. When John read the original novel "The Dream of a Ridiculous Man" written by **Fyodor Dostoyevski**, he immediately thought Margaux should read it. Both were struck by the power of this story and how beautifully constructed around a theme as important as how to **build yourself from life's tragedies** it was. Therefore, they knew they had to make a film out of it. But how do you adapt a **monologue** on the screen?

Starting from this difficult challenge, and with the help of producer Francoise Fazio, they have created a **powerful**, **disruptive**, and **innovative drama**, something truly **unique** in its genre, raising awareness on the subject of **suicide**, and how one can rebuild himself after such **tragedy**.

This motion picture is also the result of the hard work of **two young people** and their producer who refused to listen to the naysayers and fought to make a film in Switzerland, pushing the boundaries of available locations to make it look **timeless** and **without borders**. Not only were they able to create a unique film, they also probably have set a **record** in shooting an entire feature in less than two weeks and going from development to completed in less than a year.

She has directed a total of three short films, the latest one All I Can See went on to win many awards such as **Best** Women Short at the 2019 Independent Shorts Awards and she herself was the recipient of the Oniros Award for Best Director. Recently, she completed her first feature-length film "TRUTHCE". Margaux's approach to filmmaking is driven by a need to tell meaningful stories with an immersive way of shooting, breaking the barriers between the audience and the story.
